

HELVETICA

HELVETICA IS A WIDELY USED SANS-SERIF TYPEFACE DEVELOPED IN 1957

Helvetica was developed by a Swiss typeface designer Max Miedinger with the help of Eduard Hoffmann. Max Miedinger was born in Zurich in 1910 Max became an apprentice typesetter at a book printing office and later enrolled in the School of Arts & Crafts. He worked for an advertising studio called Globe, where he worked a typographer. He then was a designer at the Haas Foundry in Switzerland, where he was commissioned to produce a typeface that was a more modern version of the typeface Akzidenz-Grotesk, and as a result he created the most widely used sans serif typeface of the 20th century, Helvetica.
